## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from 1900 for Tract No. 1 and 1887 for Tract No. 2

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed for the purposes

aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed lacre feet per acre during any period of 30 days prior to July 31st of eachyear, and thereafter not to exceed lacre foot per acre during the entire remainder of the irrigation secontained in said decree.
