CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That WILLIAM E. ANLIKER

of 1050 N.W. Brockwood Avenue, Hillsboro, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Anliker Well

a tributary of Rock Creek for the purpose of irrigation of 7.0 acres

under Permit No. G-1762 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from January 20, 1961,

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.05 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected within Belknap DIC No. 43, Section 33, T. 1 N., R. 2 W., W.M. Well located North 35°20' West 990 feet from SE corner of DIC 43.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

1.3 acres SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$
5.7 acres SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$
both as projected within Belknap DIC 43
Section 33
T. 1 N., R. 2 W., W.M.

Land on which water is to be used is part of that described as follows:

Beginning at the NE corner, Lot 10, Washington Acres, a subdivision of record in Washington County, Oregon, and thence N. 00°17' E. 214.4 feet to a point on the southerly line of a 20-foot roadway; thence, on the southerly line of said roadway, which is parallel to and 20.0 feet from (measured at right angles) the southerly right-of-way line of the Oregon Electric Railroad, S. 74°10' W. 686.4 feet; thence S. 00°24' West 595.9 feet; thence North 89°56' East 20.0 feet; thence, North 00°24' East 2.8 feet; thence, South 89°03' East 639.0 feet; thence, North 00°29' East 576.48 to the place of beginning.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
