CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That James G. Dick and Clara Dick

of Kerby, State of Oregon, has a right to the use of
the waters of Sucker Creek, trib. of Illinois River
for the purpose of irrigation of 5.0 acres

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for
Josephine County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of
the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 1, at page 252; that the priority of the right thereby
confirmed dates from 1857

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an
amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.10 cubic foot per second

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant
(or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

5.0 acres in the SW¹/₄ NW¹/₄ SW¹/₄
Section 36
T. 39 S., R. 8 W., W.M.

Note: This certificate is issued to correct and supersede that certain water
right certificate heretofore issued to William M. Bunch and recorded in State
Record of Water Right Certificates, Volume 7, Page 7126, so as to correctly
describe that portion of said right presently owned by James G. Dick and Clara
Dick as directed by Decree of the Circuit Court for Josephine County dated
October 22, 1962, and Order amending said Decree dated November 27, 1962.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of
use herein described.
