## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Jackson

County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 4, at page 1; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1854;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed

0.68 cubic foot per second.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

Certificate of water right issued to John W. Wells and Heirs of Giles Wells, Deceased, and recorded at page 15985, Volume 13, State Record of Water Right Certificates, confirms a right to the use of water for irrigation of 59.2 acres and stock. Subsequently, the right to the use of water appurtenant to 4.43 acres was transferred by order of the State Engineer entered October 22, 1962. This certificate is issued to confirm the remaining right to the use of water for irrigation and supersedes the certificate heretofore issued to J. W. Wells and Heirs of Giles Wells, Deceased.
