that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed lacre foot per agre during any period of 30 days prior to July 31st of each year, and thereafter not to exceed 1 acre foot per acre during the entire remainder of the irrigation season; and said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree. A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water hereby con-

firmed is appurtenant, or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use, s as follows: 47g acres in the NWaNW1 of Section 4: 40 acres in the NW1NE1; *

13 acres in the NW1NE1 of Section 5, Township 1 North, Range 42 East of Wilis as follows: lamette Meridian and 292 acres in the SW2SF4 of Section 32. Township 2 North,

Range 42 East of Willamette Meridian, in Wallowa County, Oregon.

The right to the use of the water aforesaid hereby confirmed is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
