that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from October 1900 for Tract No. 1 and 1884 for Tract No. 2

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed for the purposes

aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 18 acre feet per acre during any period of 30 days prior to July 31st of each year. and thereafter not to exceed 1 acre foot per acre during the entire remainder of the irrigation season; and said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water hereby con-

firmed is appurtenant, or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use,

is as follows: Tract No. 1: 50 acres in the $NE_{\pm}^{1}NE_{\pm}^{1}$ (Lot 1); 45 acres in the NWINE (Lot 2) and 48 acres in the NEINW (Lot 3) of Section 4, Township 1
North, Range 42; 80 acres in the NESW4; 80 acres in the SESW4 of Section 33;
37 acres in the NEISE4 and 35 acres in the SESE4 of Section 32, Township 2 North, Range 42; All East of Willamette Meridian, in Wallows County, Oregon.

Tract No. 2: 40 acres in the SW4NW4 of Section 3, Township 1 North, Range 43 East of Willamette Meridian, in Wallowa County, Oregon.

The right to the use of the water aforesaid hereby confirmed is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
