CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

(For Rights which have been confirmed by the Courts)

This is to Certify, That WILLIAM T. E. WILSON, of Sisters, State of Oregon, has a right to the use of the waters of SQUAW CREEK, a tributary of the Deschutes River, in Crook County, Oregon,

for the purpose of power,

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Crook County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Board of Control of the State of Oregon, in Volume 1, at page 120 ; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from 1898;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed for the purpose aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purpose, and shall not exceed 12 cubic feet per second. (20 H. P.)

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water hereby confirmed is appurtenant, or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use, is as follows:

(Power used for sawmill)

The right to the use of the water aforesaid hereby confirmed is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
