CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

(For Rights which have been confirmed by the Courts)

has a right to the use of

the waters of Little Hurricane Creek, a tributary of the Wallowa River, and Wallowa River, a tributary of the Grande Ronde River

for the purpose of the irrigation of 90 acres of land

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for

Wallowa

County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order

Record of the State Water Board of the State of Oregon, in Volume

, at page 178 ;

that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from \$ 1895 for Tract No. 1 and 1885 for Tract No. 2

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed for the purposes

aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 1 acre foot per acre for Tract No. 1 and 12 acre feet per acre for Tract No. 2 during any period of 30 days prior to July 31st of each year, and thereafter not to exceed 1 acre foot per acre during the entire remainder of the irrigation season; and said rights shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water hereby con-

firmed is appurtment, or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use,

is as follows: Tradt No. 1, irrigated from Little Hurricane Creek: 25 acres in the NF $_0^1$ NW $_0^4$ and 18 acres in the NW $_0^1$ NW $_0^4$ of Section 13, Township 2 South, Range 44 East of Willamette Meridian, in Wallowa County, Oregon.

Tract No. 2, irrigated from Wallowa River: 36 acres in the NW NE and 11 acres in the NF NW of Section 13, Township 2 South, Range 44 East of Willamette Meridian, in Wallowa County, Oregon.

The right to the use of the water aforesaid hereby confirmed is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
