CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That ANTHONY BRANDENTHALER

of 204 Hillcrest Drive, Baker, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Overflow from City of Baker Reservoir a tributary of Powder River for the purpose of irrigation

under Permit No. 4378 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from December 29, 1919,

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed

0.38 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ~~one-eightieth~~ of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

2.0 acres NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$
23.0 acres NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$
5.0 acres SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$

Certificate of water right issued to Adam Kolb and recorded at page 3553, Volume 4, State Record of Water Right Certificates, confirms a right to the use of water for irrigation of 40 acres. Subsequently, the right to the use of water appurtenant to 10 acres was transferred by order of the State Engineer entered May 9, 1926, and later cancelled by order of the State Engineer entered March 19, 1963. This certificate is issued to confirm the remaining right to the use of water and supersedes the certificate heretofore issued to Adam Kolb.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
