that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed

1.56 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall

conform to such reasonable notation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

15 acres Swi Mi Section 13
15 acres Swi Mi Section 15
15 acres Swi Wi Section 15
15 acres Swi Ski Scotion 20
15 acres Swi Ski Section 20

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in place of use, approved by an order of the State Engineer entered September 2h, 195h, pursuant to the provisions of ORS 5h0.510 to 5h0.530, and supersedes certificate of water right heretofore issued to Jemes H. and Francis E. Fenrick, and recorded at page 1362, Volume 2. State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
