CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That

IYLE A. PUTNAM

of Route 2, Box 570, Elmira , State of Oregon , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of

Hendricks Branch of Long Tom River and Long Tom River

a tributary of Willamette River

for the purpose of

irrigation of 6.6 acres,

under Permit No. 18052 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from October 15, 1947,

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed

0.08 cubic foot per second, being 0.01 c.f.s. from river and 0.07 c.f.s. from Hendricks Branch,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream.

The point of diversion is located in the SEL MEL, Section 8, and NAL MAL, Section 9,

T. 17 S., R. 6 W., W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed $2\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

From Hendricks Branch 5.6 acres NN NN NN NN Section 9 T. 17 S., R. 6 W., W. M.

Certificate of water right issued to Lyle A. Putnam and recorded at page 21454, Volume 15, State Record of Water Right Certificates, confirms a right to the use of water for irrigation of 10.6 acres. Subsequently the right for the irrigation of 4.0 acres was cancelled by order of the State Engineer entered March 15, 1963, pursuant to the provisions of ORS 540.621 and 540.650. This certificate is issued to confirm the remaining right to the use of water for irrigation and supersedes the certificate heretofore issued to Lyle A. Putnam.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
