to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to store the waters of
McKenzie River, tributary of Willamette River, to be appropriated under Permit
number 17511,

for the purposes of

storage area for floating logs,
under Reservoir Permit No. R-861 of the State Engineer, and that said right to store said
waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right
hereby confirmed s from May 21, 1947,

that the amount of water entitled to be stored each year under such right, for the purposes afore-
said, shall not exceed 420 acre feet.
