CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That OREGON STATE GAME COMMISSION

of 1634 S.W. Alder, Portland 8, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of an unnamed drainageway and Whetstone Borrow Reservoir constructed under Application number R-37595, Permit number R-2989, a tributary of Rogus River for the purpose of maintenance of Whetstone Borrow Reservoir and wildlife propagation within reservoir under Permit No. 28109 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from April 30, 1962,

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed

0.5 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 19, T. 36 S., R. 1 W., W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to _____ of one cubic foot per second per acre, the period when the flow of the Rogus River is more than 1000 c.f.s. at Raygold, more than 1000 c.f.s. immediately above Savage Rapids Dam and more than 735 c.f.s. at its mouth,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
