CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

It is Is to Certify, That E. B. and/or Evelyn E. Bennett

of 1161 Riverbanks Road, Grants Pass , State of Oregon , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Dutcher Creek when available and any deficiency in the available supply in Dutcher Creek is to be made up by diversion from the Rogue River, ^{a tributary of} for the purpose of

irrigation of 1.8 acres

under Permit No. 27427 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from June 1, 1961,

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed

0.04 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the Lot 8 (SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$), Section 14, T. 36 S., R. 7 W., W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-fortieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated from Dutcher Creek and this appropriation shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated from the Rogue River and shall be still further limited to a diversion of not to exceed $\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year; provided further that the right to the use of water is limited to the period when the flow of the Rogue River is more than 735 c.f.s. at its mouth,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

1.8 acres Lot 8 (SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$)
Section 14
T. 36 S., R. 7 W., W. M.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
