CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

(For Rights which have been confirmed by the Courts)

This is to Certify, That FRANK SPORELEDER,

of R.F.D.2, Walla Walla, State of Washington, has a right to the use of the waters of EAST BRANCH OF MUD CREEK, a tributary of the Walla Walla River, in Umatilla County, Oregon,

for the purpose sof irrigation and stock; (Irrigation season: from March to September of each year)

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Imatilia County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Board of Control of the State of Oregon, in Volume 1, at page 113; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from 1892;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed for the purpose's aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purpose's, and shall not exceed 0.13 cubic feet per second, not to exceed the rate of one-fortieth (1/40) of a second foot to each one thousand (1000) head of stock.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water hereby confirmed is appurtenant, or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use, is as follows:

Ten (10) acres in $SW_4^{\frac{1}{4}}$ of $SE_4^{\frac{1}{4}}$, Sec. 16, T. 6 N., R. 35 E., W. M., in Umatilla County, Oregon.

The right to the use of the water aforesaid hereby confirmed is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
