CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

(For Rights which have been confirmed by the Courts)

This is to Certify, That L. P. McCUBBIN

of Enterprise, State of Oregon has a right to the use of the waters of Wallowa River, a tributary of the Grande Ronde River, and Prairie Creek, a tributary of the Wallowa River

for the purpose of the irrigation of 148 acres of land, domestic and stock use

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for

Wallowa County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order

Record of the State Water Board of the State of Oregon, in Volume 5, at page 183;

that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from November 12, 1900 for Tract No. 1 and 1889 for Tract No. 2

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed for the purposes

aforsaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 1 1/2 acre feet per acre during any period of 30 days prior to July 31st of each year, and thereafter not to exceed 1 acre foot per acre during the entire remainder of the irrigation season for Tract No. 1 and one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre for Tract No. 2; and said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water hereby con-

firmed is appurtenant, or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use,

is as follows: Tract No. 1, irrigated from Wallowa River: 40 acres in the SW 1/4 NW 1/4; 34 acres in the SW 1/4 NW 1/4; 38 1/2 acres in the NE 1/4 SW 1/4 and 15 acres in the NW 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 7, Township 2 South, Range 45 and 15 1/2 acres in the SE 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 12, Township 2 South, Range 44, All East of Willamette Meridian, in Wallowa County, Oregon.

Tract No. 2, irrigated from Prairie Creek: 5 acres in the SE 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 7, Township 2 South, Range 45 East of Willamette Meridian, in Wallowa County, Oregon.

The right to the use of the water aforsaid hereby confirmed is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
