CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

(For Rights which have been confirmed by the Courts)

This is to Certify, That CHAS. W. MEEK

of Joseph, State of Oregon has a right to the use of the waters of Prairie Creek, a tributary of the Wallowa River

for the purpose of the irrigation of 11 acres of land and the development of 22 horsepower, domestic and stock use

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Wallowa County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the State Water Board of the State of Oregon, in Volume 5, at page 184;

that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from 1880 for the irrigation of 11 acres; 1878 for stock and domestic use and 1880 for power

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre for irrigation, domestic and stock and 7.75 cubic feet per second for power; and said rights shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water hereby confirmed is appurtenant, or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use, is as follows: Water sufficient to irrigate any 11 acres in the following described tracts: 30 acres in the NW 1/4 SE 1/4; 7 acres in the SW 1/4 S 1/4 and 3 acres in the SE 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 14, Township 3 South, Range 45 East of Willamette Meridian, in Wallowa County, Oregon.

Saw Mill in the NW 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 14, Township 3 South, Range 45 East of Willamette Meridian, in Wallowa County, Oregon.

The right to the use of the water aforesaid hereby confirmed is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
