that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed for the purposes

aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed le acre feet per acre during any period of 30 days prior to July 31st of each year, and thereafter not to exceed 1 acre foot per acre during the entire remainder of the irrigation season for irrigation and 0.25 cubic feet per second for ice and fish ponds, and said rights shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained insaid decree. A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water hereby con-

firmed is appurtenant, or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use,

Fish and Icc Fond in the SW4NW of Section 33. Township 2 South, Range 45 East of Willamette Meridian, in Wallowa County, Oregon.

The right to the use of the water aforesaid hereby confirmed is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
