CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That WILLAMETTE LUTHERAN HOURS, INC.

of P. 3. Box 68, Salom , State of 0regon , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Clear Lake

a tributary of Willamette River

for the purpose of

irrigation of 14.8 acres,

under Permit No. 24741 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from February 25, 1957,

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed

0.173 cubic foot per second,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the $M_1 \subseteq M_2$, Section 23, Township 6 South, Range 3 West, M_2 .

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one—eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed $2\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

12.2 acres MI SI SI SI SECTION 23 Section 23 Township 6 South, Range 3 West, I. H.

Certificate of water right issued to C. A. Bender, Jr. and recorded at page 2649k, Volume 18, State Record of Mater Right Certificates, confirms a right to the use of water for irrigation of 17.0 acres. Subsequently, the right to the use of water appurtment to 2.2 acres was cancelled by order of the State Engineer entered June 2k, 1963. This certificate is issued to confirm the remaining right to the use of water for irrigation and supersedes the certificate heretofore issued to C. A. Bender, Jr.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
