CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That the CITY OF UNION

of UNION, State of OREGON, has a right to the use of the waters of Catherine Creek, tributary of Grande Ronde River for the purpose of Municipal use

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Union County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 8, at page 1; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1893

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 3.0 cubic feet per second

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

Within the corporate limits of the City of Union, Oregon Sections 13 & 24 T. 4 S., R. 39 E., W. 11. Sections 18 & 19 T. 4 S., R. 40 E., W. 11.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree. The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
