## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

a tributary of Umpqua River Irrigation of 4.25 acres

for the purpose of

under Permit No. 27271 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from March 20, 1961,

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.05 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the Lot 2 (ML,  $M_{\bullet}$ ), Section 1,  $M_{\bullet}$ . 25 Sec.,  $M_{\bullet}$  5 We,

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or 1ts equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not so exceed 2, acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year; provided further that the right to the use of water is limited to the period when the flow of the Galaccoya Creek is more than 12.0 c.f.s. at its mouth,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

2.00 acres SW4 MM4 2.25 acres Lot 2 (NW4 SW4) Section 4 T. 25 G., N. 5 J., W. N.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
