## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

**This Is to Certify, That**

DAVID M. & SARA K. WELCH, TRUMAN D. &  
 Z. IDELLE COLLINS, JOHN J. & LOUELLA E.  
 DICKENSON, & GEORGE P. & FLORENCE S. WALLER  
 of Box 572, Tioga, State of North Dakota, has made proof  
 to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of  
 Rogue River

a tributary of Pacific Ocean  
 domestic, stock and irrigation

for the purpose of

under Permit No. 12635 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters  
 has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby  
 confirmed dates from May 7, 1937,

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes  
 aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed  
 0.27 cubic foot per second, being 0.01 c.f.s. for domestic, 0.01 c.f.s. for  
 stock and 0.25 c.f.s. for irrigation

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream.  
 The point of diversion is located in the Lot 1 (NE $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$ ), Sec. 15 for Welch, Collins and  
 Dickenson, and Lot 1 (SE $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$ ), Sec. 15 for Waller, T. 34 S., R. 1 W., W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other  
 right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second  
 per acre or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to  
 a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$  acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during  
 the irrigation season of each year,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is  
 appurtenant, is as follows:

Domestic and stock Lot 1 (SE $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$ )  
 Welch 0.90 acres Lot 1 (NE $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$ )  
 Collins 0.75 acres Lot 1 (NE $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$ )  
 Dickinson 2.00 acres Lot 1 (NE $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$ )  
 Waller 4.35 acres Lot 1 (NE $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$ )  
 Waller 12.00 acres Lot 1 (SE $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$ )  
 Section 15

This certificate is issued to confirm changes in points of diversion  
 approved by orders of the State Engineer entered April 20, 1962, May 15, 1962,  
 July 25, 1962 pursuant to the provisions of ORS 540.510 to 540.530, and  
 supersedes certificate of water right heretofore issued to George P. and  
 Florence S. Waller and recorded at page 12271, Volume 11, State Record of  
 Water Right Certificates.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of  
 use herein described.
