CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That

CLARENCE L. and WINIFRED A. STONE

of Idleyld Route, Box 193, Roseburg, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of North Dear Creek

a tributary of

South Umpqua River

for the purpose of

irrigation of 1.0 acre and domestic use of one family

under Permit No. 2828h of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from July 27, 1962, for 0.01 c.f.s. and August 31, 1962, for 0.01 c.f.s.,

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.02 cubic foot per second, being 0.01 c.f.s. for each use,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NW4 SW2, as projected within Cox DIC No. 141, Section 21, T. 27 S., R. 4 W., W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed $2\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year; provided further that the right to the use of water is limited to the period when the flow of the South Umpqua River is more than 60.0 c.f.s. at its mouth,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

1.0 acre and domestic Wid SWid as projected within Cox DLC his Section 21
T. 27 S., R. i W., W. M.

Land on which water is to be used is part of that described as follows:

Lots 11 and 12, Oak Grove Park.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
