that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.37 cubic foot per second, being 0.22 c.f.s. from Well #1 for manufacturing, and 0.15 c.f.s. from Well #2 for maintainance of log pond constructed under App. No. R-37396;

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the Well No. 1 - SE4 NW4, as projected within Burbank DLC 63, Sec. 21; No. 2 - SE4 NW4, as projected within Cook DLC 63, Section 21, T. 8 S., R. 4 W., W. M. Well locations below.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to—————— of one cubic foot μ er second per acre,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Well No. 1 located 299 feet North and 2790 feet East; Well No. 2 located 558 feet South and 2768 feet East; both from NW corner of DLC 63.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
