CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That BATE LUMBER COMPANY

of Box 107, Merlin, State of Oregon, has a right to the use of
the waters of Louse Creek, a tributary of Jump-Off-Joe Creek

for the purpose of manufacturing during the period April 1st to November 1st of each
year

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for
Jackson County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of
the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 4, at page 1; that the priority of the right thereby
confirmed dates from June 25, 1893,

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an
amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.25 cubic foot per
second

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant
(or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$
Section 21
T. 35 S., R. 6 W., W. M.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in use and place of use
approved by an order of the State Engineer entered January 9, 1961 pursuant
to the provisions of ORS 540.510 to 540.530, and supersedes certificate of
water right heretofore issued to Frank E. Moody and recorded at page 16509,
Volume 13, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of
use herein described.
