## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That B. F. BREWER

of Milton-Freewater

, State of Oregon

, has a right to the use of

the waters of Dry Creek, tributary of Pine Creek

for the purpose of irrigation of 21.3 acres

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Umatilla County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume: 7, at page 148; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1891

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed one acre foot per acre during any thirty-day period, nor three acre feet per acre during the irrigation season beginning April 1 and ending October 1.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

Certificate of water right issued to B. F. Brewer and recorded at page 5513, Volume 6, State Record of Water Right Certificates, confirms a right to the use of water for irrigation of 65 acres. Subsequently, the right to the use of water appurtenant to 43.7 acres was canceled by order of the State Engineer entered October 10, 1963. This certificate is issued to confirm the remaining right to the use of water for irrigation and supersedes the certificate heretofore issued to B. F. Brewer.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
