CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That A. B. HENNINGSEN
c/o Mrs. Lee Hoag

of 221 N. Central Avenue, Medford, State of Oregon, has a right to the use of

the waters of Springs tributary of Ora Creek

for the purpose of irrigation of 9 acres

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Jackson County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 4, at page 1; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1906

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.23 cubic foot per second

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

9 acres SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$
Section 21
T. 33 S., R. 2 E., W. M.

This certificate is issued pursuant to the order of the Circuit Court of Jackson County to correctly show the location of the lands irrigated and supersedes the certificate issued to R. E. Peyton recorded at page 15881, Volume 13, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree. The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
