This Is to Certify, That SQUAW CREEK IRRIGATION DISTRICT

of Star Route, Redmond, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to store the waters of Squaw Creek Irrigation District Canal in McKenzie Canyon Regulating Reservoir

regulation of flow in the Squaw Creek Irrigation District Canal for the purposes of diverting water under existing rights for irrigation within the district under Reservoir Permit No. R-2004 of the State Engineer, and that said right to store said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right heretofore confirmed dates from May 31, 1957,

that the amount of water entitled to be stored each year under such right, for the purposes aforesaid, shall not exceed 89.0 acre feet.
