Wallowa County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order
Record of the State Water Board of the State of Oregon, in Volume 5, at page 190;
that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from 1890

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed for the purposes

aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 12 acre feet per acre during any period of 30 days prior to Jul; 31st of each year, and thereafter not to exceed 1 acre foot per acre during the entire remainder of the irrigation season; and said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree and under such right, and to which the water hereby con-

firmed is appurtenant, or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use, is as follows: 40 acres in the SE<sub>4</sub><sup>1</sup>NW<sub>4</sub> and 40 acres in the NE<sub>4</sub><sup>1</sup>SW<sub>4</sub> of Section 34, Township 2 North, Hange 42 East of Willamette Meridian, in Wallowa County, Oregon.

The right to the use of the water aforesaid hereby confirmed is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
