for the purpose of the irrigation of 242 acres of land

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for

Wallowa County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order

Record of the State Water Board of the State of Oregon, in Volume 5, at page 190;

that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from 1890

that the amount of water to which such right is critiled and hereby confirmed for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed a cree feet per acree during any period of 30 days prior to July 31st of each year, and thereafter not to exceed 1 acree foot per acree during the entire remainder of the irrigation exason; and said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said degree under such right, and to which the water hereby con-

firmed is appurtenant, or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use, is as follows:  $2\frac{1}{2}$  acres in the  $SE\frac{1}{2}SW_{4}^{1}$  of Section 27; 2 acres in the  $NE\frac{1}{4}NE\frac{1}{4}$  and 20 acres in the  $NE\frac{1}{4}NW_{4}^{1}$  of Section 34, Township 2 North, Range 42 East of Willamette Meridian, in Wallowa County, Oregon.

The right to the use of the water aforesaid hereby confirmed is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
