## **CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT**

This Is to Certify, That EIWIN CONKLIN and GUY GILLETT

of 9367 S. W. Morrison, Portland , State of Oregon , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of an unnamed stream

a tributary of McKay Creek for the purpose of domestic use for two families, including irrigation of not to exceed  $\frac{1}{2}$  acre per family lawn and garden under Permit No. 25589 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters

ander Permit No. 25589 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said accord has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from June 23, 1958,

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.01 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the Lot 2,  $(SE_4^1 NW_4^1)$ , Section 29, T. 2 N., R. 2 W., W. N.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to --- of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer. A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

> Domestic SWA NWA as projected within Davis DIC 1/2 Lot 2 (SEA NWA) Section 29 T. 2 N., R. 2 N., W. M.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
