CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That FRANK H. & LUCILLE P. GOFF

of 2305 Pacific Avenue, Forest Grove, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Carpenter Creek

a tributary of Gales Creek for the purpose of fish culture

under Permit No. 26045 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from September 3, 1954,

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.03 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NE 1/4 NE 1/4, Section 9, T. 1 S., R. 4 W., W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to - - - - - of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Fish culture
NE 1/4 NE 1/4
Section 9
T. 1 S., R. 4 W., W. M.

The diversion of water as allowed herein for fish culture shall be subordinate and inferior to all future appropriations on Carpenter Creek and its tributaries for domestic, stock, municipal, irrigation or industrial uses and for storage for such uses.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
