CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That WASHINGTON COUNTY
 of Hillsboro, State of Oregon, has made proof
 to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to store the waters of
 Jackson Creek, tributary of McKay Creek (Tualatin River)

for the purposes of
 storage in Jackson Quarry Reservoir for use as a desilting pond for return flow
 of water appropriated for rock quarry operation
 under Reservoir Permit No. R-2698 of the State Engineer, and that said right to store said
 waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right
 hereby confirmed dates from October 25, 1961,

that the amount of water entitled to be stored each year under such right, for the purposes afore-
 said, shall not exceed 18.6 acre feet.
