CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That HARVEY and LUCY McALLISTER

of Dufur, State of Oregon, has a right to the use of the waters of Ramsey Creek, tributary of Fifteenmile Creek for Tracts 1 and 2 and Fifteenmile Creek for Tract 3 for the purpose of irrigation of 42.0 acres

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Wasco County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 7, at page 406; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1861 for Tract 1, 1866 for Tract 2, 1867 for Tract 3

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 3 acre feet per acre in any irrigation season.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:
