CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That WILLARD FIX

of Bend, State of Oregon, has a right to the use of
the waters of Deschutes River
for the purpose of irrigation

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for
Deschutes County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of
the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 9, at page 362; that the priority of the right thereby
confirmed dates from October 31, 1900

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an
amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.028 cubic foot per
second

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant
(or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

2.0 acres SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$
Section 20
T. 17 S., R. 12 E., W. M.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in place of use and point of
diversion approved by an order of the State Engineer entered April 13, 1959
pursuant to the provisions of ORS 540.510 to 540.530, and together with the cert-
ificate recorded at page 31420, Volume 23, supersedes certificate of water right
heretofore issued to L. D. Wiest and recorded at page 20242, Volume 14, State
Record of Water Right Certificates.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of
use herein described.
