CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

for the purpose of the irrigation of $63\frac{1}{2}$ acres of land, domestic and stock use

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Wallowa County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the State Water Board of the State of Oregon, in Volume 5, at page 191; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from 1900

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed for the purposes

aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 1 acre foot per acre during any period of 30 kys prior to July 31st of each yex, and thereafter not to exceed 1 acre foot per acre during the entire remainder of the irrigation season; and said dright shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said drere. A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water hereby con-

firmed is appurtenant, or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use,

is as follows: 16 acres in the SW\(\frac{1}{2}\)NW\(\frac{1}{4}\) and 15 acres in the NW\(\frac{1}{2}\)SW\(\frac{1}{4}\) of Section 12 and 32\(\frac{1}{2}\) acres in the SE\(\frac{1}{2}\)NE\(\frac{1}{2}\) of Section 11, Township 2 South, Range 44 East of Willamette Meridian, in Wallowa County, Oregon. (This right is supplemental to right through the Island Irrigating Water Ditch Company's ditch)

The right to the use of the water aforesaid hereby confirmed is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
