## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That ROSS B. HAMMOND

of Box 2111, Portland 14, State of Oregon, has a right to the use of  
the waters of Squaw Creek, tributary of Deschutes River  
for the purpose of irrigation

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for  
Deschutes County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of  
the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 1, at page 120; that the priority of the right thereby  
confirmed dates from 1886,

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an  
amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.56 cubic foot per  
second

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant  
(or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

14 acres NE $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$   
9 acres SE $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$   
Section 8  
5 acres NW $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$   
Section 9  
T. 15 S., R. 10 E., W. M.

Certificate of water right issued to Ross B. Hammond and recorded at page  
24482, Volume 17, State Record of Water Right Certificates, confirms a right to  
the use of water for irrigation of 58 acres. Subsequently, the right to the use  
of water appurtenant to 30 acres was transferred by order of the State Engineer  
entered February 10, 1964. This certificate is issued to confirm the remaining  
right to the use of water for irrigation and supersedes the certificate heretofore  
issued to Ross B. Hammond.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.  
The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of  
use herein described.
