## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That CHARLES SEEFIELD

of Lake Creck

state of Oregon

, has a right to the use of

the waters of South Fork of Little Butte Creek

for the purpose of irrigation, domestic and stock

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Jackson County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 14, at page 198; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from November, 1906

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.25 cubic foot per second; measured at the head of the ditch or the point where the same leaves the natural stream, from April 1st to October 1st of each year.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

Certificate of water right issued to Charles Seefield and recorded at page 1721, Volume 11, State Record of Water Right Certificates, confirms a right to the use of water for irrigation of 12.0 acres domestic and stock. Subsequently, the right to the use of water appurtenant to 2.0 acres was transferred by order of the State Engineer entered December 21, 1962. This certificate is issued to confirm the remaining right to the use of water and supersedes the certificate heretofore issued to Charles Seefield.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree. The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
