## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

(For Rights which have been confirmed by the Courts)

This is to Certify, The	hat MRS.	EC.	ROCHEFORD	

of Cove , State of Oregon has a right to the use of the waters of Wallowa River, a tributary of the Grande Ronde River

for the purpose of the irrigation of 60 acres of land

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for
Wallowa County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order
Record of the State Water Board of the State of Oregon, in Volume 5 , at page 191;
that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from 1895

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed \$1\frac{1}{2}\$ acre feet per acre during any period of 30 days prior to July 31st of each year, and thereafter not to exceed \$1\$ are foot per acre during the entire remainder of the irrigation season; and said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water hereby confirmed is appurtenant, or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use, is as follows:

30 acres in the \$S\mathbb{N}\frac{1}{4}\$ and 30 acres in the \$S\mathbb{L}\frac{1}{4}\$S\mathbb{N}\frac{1}{4}\$ of Section 29, Township 1 South, Range 44 Fast of Willamette Meridian, in Wallowa County, Oregon.

The right to the use of the water aforesaid hereby confirmed is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
