CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That E. J. FISCHER

of 2375 Alameda Street, Salem, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of two wells

a tributary of Little Pudding River for the purpose of quasi-municipal (all of the purposes for which water could be used in a city under a right initiated for municipal use) under Permit No. G-148 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from February 23, 1956,

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.20 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NW 1/4 SW 1/4 & SW 1/4 SW 1/4, both as projected within Baker DLC 91, Section 19, T. 7 S., R. 2 W., W. M.; Wells located 509 feet South and 981 feet West, and 22 feet South and 178 feet West both from NE cor., DLC 91.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to - - - - - of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

NE 1/4 SW 1/4
NW 1/4 SW 1/4
SW 1/4 SW 1/4
SE 1/4 SW 1/4

all as projected within Baker DLC 91
Section 19
T. 7 S., R. 2 W., W. M.

Land on which water is to be used is part of that described as follows:

Belvedere Gardens

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
