CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That GILBERT A. and W. L. STENCER
and ROBERT P. and ROSE KLOFT

of P. O. Box 70, Woodburn, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Butte Creek

a tributary of Pudding River for the purpose of
irrigation of 28.0 acres

under Permit No. 20024 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from November 30, 1950,

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.35 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ & SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, both as projected within Chase DIC 46, Section 23, T. 5 S., R. 1 W., W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

16.9 acres SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$
4.4 acres W $\frac{1}{2}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$
Section 23
7.7 acres NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$
Section 26
T. 5 S., R. 1 W., W. M.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in point of diversion approved by an order of the State Engineer entered June 4, 1957, and supersedes certificate of water right heretofore issued to Gilbert A. & W. L. Stenger and recorded at page 21225, Volume 15, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
