CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That DAIE CALL

of Kerby , State of Oregon , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of three springs and reservoir constructed under application to Machine No. R-2586 a tributary of Illinois River for the purpose of irrigation, supplemental irrigation and fish culture

under Permit No. 27187 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from January 21, 1961,

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.17 cubic foot per second, being 0.07 c.f.s. for irrigation and 0.10 c.f.s. for fish culture; 0.04 c.f.s. from spring #1, 0.07 c.f.s. from spring #2 and 0.06 c.f.s. from spring #3, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NN SEL, Section 9, T. 39 S., R. 8 W., W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-fiftieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated from direct flow and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3½ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year from direct flow and storage from reservoir to be constructed under permit number R-2586; provided further that the right to the use of direct flow is limited to the period when the flow of the Rogue River is more than 735 c.f.s. at its mouth and the flow of the Illinois River is more than 80 c.f.s. at its mouth,

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Primary Supplemental

NW4 SE4 fish culture and 0.2 3.3
Section 9
T. 39 S., R. 8 W., W. M.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
