This Is to Certify, That RALPH SIEGMUND

of Route 1, Box 321, Stayton, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to store the waters of Bartamus Creek, tributary of North Santiam River, appropriated under Application No. 32411, Permit No. 26047,

for the purposes of irrigation and maintenance of log pond under Reservoir Permit No. R-2228 of the State Engineer, and that said right to store said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from June 23, 1958.

that the amount of water entitled to be stored each year under such right, for the purposes aforesaid, shall not exceed 13.3 acre feet.
