CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That HALBERT GERKING

of Route 1, Box 75, The Dalles, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Eightmile Creek

a tributary of Fifteemile Creek for the purpose of irrigation of 7.5 acres

under Permit No. 2715 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from November 15, 1915,

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.09 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 11, T. 1 S., R. 13 E., W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

7.5 acres SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$
Section 11
T. 1 S., R. 13 E., W. M.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in point of diversion approved by an order of the State Engineer entered November 7, 1960, and together with the certificate recorded at page 31661, Volume 23, supersedes certificate of water right heretofore issued to M. Longren, D. S. Doyle, J. N. Williams and Amanda Williams and recorded at page 2839, Volume 4, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
