## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

**This Is to Certify, That** ED BURKE

of Karby, State of Oregon, has a right  
to the use of the waters of East Fork Illinois River

a tributary of Illinois River for the purpose of  
irrigation

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Josephine County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 13, at page 70; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from May, 1887;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed one cubic foot per second for each 50 acres of land irrigated during the irrigation season from April 1 to November 1 of each year.

The point of diversion is located in the - - - -

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

13.5 acres NE $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$   
Section 9  
T. 39 S., R. 8 W., W. M.

Certificate of water right issued to Ed Burke and recorded at page 13839, Volume 12, State Record of Water Right Certificates, confirms a right to the use of water for irrigation of 18.5 acres. Subsequently, the right to the use of water appurtenant to 5.0 acres was transferred by order of the State Engineer entered April 16, 1964. This certificate is issued to confirm the remaining right to the use of water for irrigation and supersedes the certificate heretofore issued to Ed Burke.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree. The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
