CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That S. A. MILLER

of Freewater, State of Oregon, has a right to the use of the waters of Walla Walla River for Tract No. 1, and Ford Branch of Walla Walla River for Tract No. 2 a tributary of Columbia River for the purpose of irrigation

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Umatilla County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 12, at page 9; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1883 for Tract No. 1, and 1901 for 19.42 acres and 1908 for 10.28 acres in Tract No. 2;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed one and one-half miner's inches per acre measured at the point of diversion

The point of diversion is located in the - - - -

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Tract No. 1 3.73 acres NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$
Section 12

T. 5 N., R. 35 E., W. M., being within the following described tract: Commencing at a point 40 rods south of the northwest corner of Section 12, T. 5 N., R. 35 E., W. M., running thence south 40 rods; thence east 25 rods; thence north 16 rods; thence east 15 rods; thence north 24 rods; thence west 40 rods to the place of beginning, containing 8.25 acres, more or less.

Tract No. 2 29.7 acres NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$
Section 34

T. 6 N., R. 35 E., W. M., being within the E $\frac{1}{2}$ of NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, and the E $\frac{1}{2}$ of W $\frac{1}{2}$ of NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of said Section 34.

(NOTE: The use of water (Tr. #2 only) is limited to the water available in excess of what is required to fill the permanent rights having a priority of 1908 or earlier.)

Certificate of water right issued to S. A. Miller and recorded at page 12917, Volume 11, State Record of Water Right Certificates, confirms a right to the use of water for irrigation of 36.73 acres. Subsequently, the right to the use of water appurtenant to 3.3 acres was transferred by order of the State Engineer entered October 18, 1963. This certificate is issued to confirm the remaining right to the use of water for irrigation and supersedes the certificate heretofore issued to S. A. Miller.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree. The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
