of Route 2, Box 244, Sherwood , State of Oregon , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Willamette River and reservoirs constructed under Permit number R-1625

a tributary of Columbia River irrigation of 29.7 acres

for the purpose of

under Permit No. 24965 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from May 21, 1957

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.37 cubic foot per second from river and 74.25 acre foot from storage

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NE4 SE4, as projected within Daily DLC #47, Section 29, T. 3 S., R. 1 W., W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightleth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated from direct flow and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed $2\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year from direct flow and storage from reservoir constructed under Permit number R-1625, and is subject to the terms of contract No. 14-06-100-1248, dated July 8, 1957 between the U. S. A. through the Bureau of Reclamation and the applicant, a copy of which is on file in the office of the State Engineer,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
