## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That FRED WETLE

of The Dalles, State of Oregon, has a right  
to the use of the waters of Chenowith Creek

a tributary of Columbia River for the purpose of  
irrigation and stock

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for  
Wasco County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of  
the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 10, at page 219; that the priority of the right thereby  
confirmed dates from 1860

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an  
amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 3 acre feet per acre,  
measured at the point of diversion from the stream, which may be diverted at a  
rate not to exceed 1/60th of one cubic foot per second per acre during the irri-  
gation season from March 1 to October 1 of each year.

Certificate of water right issued to Fred Wetle and recorded at page 14568,  
Volume 12, State Record of Water Right Certificates, confirms a right to the use  
of water for irrigation of 44.2 acres. Subsequently, the right to use of water  
appurtenant to 3.8 acres was transferred and change in point of diversion for 18.2  
acres was approved by order of the State Engineer entered August 25, 1964. This  
certificate is issued to confirm the remaining right to the use of water for irri-  
gation and stock and supersedes the certificate heretofore issued to Fred Wetle.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.  
The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place  
of use herein described.
