that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 1 cubic foot per second for each 50 acres of land irrigated during the irrigation season from April 1 to November 1 of each year

Certificate of water right issued to Estate of J. W. Seat and recorded at page 13919, Volume 12, State Record of Water Right Certificates, confirms a right to the use of water for irrigation of 205.9 acres. Subsequently, the right to the use of water appurtenant to 180.9 acres was canceled by orders of the State Engineer entered March 10, 1964 and August 31, 1964. This certificate is issued to confirm the remaining right to the use of water for irrigation and supersedes the certificate heretofore issued to Estate of J. W. Seat.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
