CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That DAVID A. and ROSAMARY DILLON

c/o William M. Sloan
of 220 Southeast H Street, Grants Pass, State of Oregon 97526 has a right
to the use of the waters of Rough and Ready Creek

a tributary of West Fork Illinois River for the purpose of
irrigation of 25.0 acres
and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for
Josephine County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of
the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 13, at page 70; that the priority of the right thereby
confirmed dates from 1902

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an
amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 1 cubic foot per second
for each 50 acres of land irrigated during the irrigation season from April 1 to
November 1 of each year

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as
follows:

Certificate of water right issued to Estate of J. W. Seat and recorded at
page 13919, Volume 12, State Record of Water Right Certificates, confirms a right
to the use of water for irrigation of 205.9 acres. Subsequently, the right to the
use of water appurtenant to 180.9 acres was canceled by orders of the State
Engineer entered March 10, 1964 and August 31, 1964. This certificate is issued
to confirm the remaining right to the use of water for irrigation and supersedes
the certificate heretofore issued to Estate of J. W. Seat.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place
of use herein described.
